While we would prefer that the show go on, the health and welfare of our exhibitors, judges, members, and all those who work to make the show a success is paramount. In the event of cancellation due to COVID-19 restrictions, any entries submitted will be refunded minus any processing fees. The shows outlined safety requirements will be included in the judging program and will be based on the AKC Best Practices (available at akc.org), the Minnesota State suggested practices, and suggestions from the Center for Disease Control.

Familiarize Yourself With The COVID-19 Exhibitor Important Notice

THESE RULES WILL APPLY TO ALL EVENTS. BRING YOUR MASK.

Judges, exhibitors, and anyone attending these events are required to wear a mask while on show grounds. Failure of exhibitors to adhere to this policy may cause them to be excused from the ring, asked to leave the building, or show site and/or face disciplinary action.

An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death. By making an entry and attending the events listed in this premium list, you voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to COVID-19 and agree to hold harmless; the club, event secretary, venue and any other exhibitor for any transmission of any disease including, but not limited to the COVID-19 virus.

Grooming

There will be no general grooming available in The Paw or ringside, so if you have back to back classes, please be prepared to have someone help with holding your dogs. To help maintain social distance, we recommend everyone plan to crate and groom from your car and the parking area. There is plenty of parking in The Paw lot so we recommend parking every other space to give everyone optimum grooming area and to provide room next to each vehicle for moving and maintaining distance.

With there being outside grooming only, please plan to bring necessary equipment for the safety of your animals, including (but not limited to) sunshades, fans, water buckets, water, and sun tents. Please note there is no space to secure a tent into the ground, so plan to also have something to secure it to your car if needed in windy conditions. With this being an outdoor show, there is plenty of room to distance both in the parking lot and around the ring.

Ring Side Spectating

There will be no chairs provided around the rings, you are welcome to spectate and sit during the show with your household. There is more than enough space to watch and maintaining 6' distance is expected between non-household groups. You will need to provide your own chair to sit and watch.

AKC Guidelines

Quick Highlights:

- Practice social distancing, avoid congregating
- Wear masks
- Avoid shaking hands, hugging and other physical contact, avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility
- Bring your own pen/pencil, sanitizer, and mask
- Maintain social distance while showing your dog

Exhibitor Important Notice – COVID-19 Information

The following additional rules/laws/regulations shall apply to all exhibitors entering these shows.

- No one may attend these events if they (or any household member) have active Covid-19 or have tested positive for Covid-19 within 2 weeks of the show
- All federal, state, and local guidelines **MUST** be followed, without exception, i.e., the use of masks, social distancing, etc. apply to all participants. This includes the CDC recommendation for wearing masks or cloth face coverings when in public settings and when around people who do not live in your household. **Exhibitors will need to bring their own masks.**
- Please allow a minimum of 6 feet between grooming spaces in the parking area. (Recommended to leave a parking space between each vehicle.)
- Hand sanitizer and disinfecting wipes will be available at the show site. However, please plan on bringing your own for individual use.
- If you are ill, feel unwell, coughing, sneezing, running a temperature, please stay home!

If you enter this show, be sure that you are comfortable with these guidelines and are willing to comply. If an exhibitor or attendee is found in violation of these guidelines, you will be excused from the show (with no refund). By signing your entry form you acknowledge that you are entering the show at your own risk. Neither the Twin Cities Vizsla Club, The Paw nor the American Kennel Club can guarantee your safety or good health and exhibitors agree to hold the above-named organizations harmless in respect to these rules. Due to the constantly changing requirements we will post the most updated information related to rules in the Judging Program and on the TCVC website: www.tcvc.org.

General Practices

Clubs, officials & participants are required to follow state, local & facility guidelines that apply to the area & site where the event is held. Exhibitors should wash hands as frequently as possible. Avoid shaking hands, hugging, or other physical contact. Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility. Avoid common use pens/pencils – bring your own. Exhibitors must provide their own scoops for cleaning up from their dogs. Prepare to be self-sufficient: bring sanitizer, bring personal use masks. Know the armband numbers for your entries before going to the ring. Do not congregate at the ring or ring gate. While showing your dog, maintain social distances with other exhibitors.

Exposure to COVID-19

If you have recently been in the presence of a person who has either tested positive for Covid-19 or has the symptoms (coughing /sneezing /temperature) please stay home.

- Social Distancing is important & will be enforced.
- The building and entire show site is smoke free.
- Place all cigarette butts in proper receptacles prior to arriving on show grounds.
- NO scoops will be provided. Please bring your own scoops or plastic bags. There are many receptacles on the show site for waste.
- Masks or Face Shields will be required to enter The Paw and the outside show ring and expected to be worn the entire time you are on the show grounds.
- ALL Exhibitors must enter through the outside right hand double gate labeled ENTER ONLY (to the right of The Paw main entrance). There is also another gate there labeled EXIY ONLY to help with distance and the flow of traffic. Please use the appropriate gate and not use The Paw entrance.
- Secretary's Table will have two lanes available for Secretary business. Exhibitors waiting to be helped must maintain 6-foot distance from the next patron. Forms will be handed out upon request. Exhibitors are required to bring & use their own pen to fill out forms. There will not be a "look at" catalog available. No paper copies of the judge results will be available at the shows.

Please Respect Our Show Site

This is a SELF-CLEAN Show Site, please respect our show site and clean up after yourself and your dogs. This includes the entire parking lot area.

- Please be prepared to provide your own form of shade or pop-up tent for outdoor grooming.
- NO INSIDE GROOMING or GROOMING TENT Available – Bring your own form of shade.
- No ex-pens or mats allowed on any grass.
- No Dogs allowed in restrooms.
- No washing dog bowls or buckets in restrooms.
- No chairs will be available for spectators. Please bring your own if you wish to sit and watch ring side. Social distancing is expected from people you do not live with.

Best of Breed Competition

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs that, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. Entering and showing dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90-day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by the American Kennel Club, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by the AKC.

Award of Merit

The judge may, at his/her discretion, recall into the ring one of the Best of Breed entry to receive a Judge's Award of Merit. This Award is reserved for a quality animal the judge feels is worthy of final consideration for Best of Breed. The Award of Merit winner will be selected after the Best of Breed, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog & Select Bitch awards are made. All dogs remaining in competition, including Winners Dog & Winners Bitch are eligible for an Award of Merit.

Non-Regular (Additional) Classes Involving Single Dog Entries

Veteran Dog Class - A Class for Dogs seven (7) years & under nine (9) years.

Veteran Dog Class - A Class for Dogs nine (9) years & under eleven (11) years.

The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition, but MUST be entered in the Stud Dog Class, the Get MUST be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the regular fee plus the additional class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get.

Brood Bitch Class - Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Master Class

Novice Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

Open Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

Junior, Intermediate and Senior Classes - are each divided by age. A Junior class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show. The Intermediate class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show. The Senior class shall be for the boys and girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

Master Class - will be for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

No entry may be changed or cancelled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Superintendent or Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hour for entries, except that a correction may be made from one age division to another, as well as, move from Master to Open or Open to Novice if a win has been disallowed or the Junior miscalculated number of placements, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry, BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for junior showmanship classes is entered on front and back of entry form. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department (919) 233-9767 or juniors@akc.org.

Per the AKC Action dated April 9, 2020, Junior Handlers who turn 18 on or after March 31 may compete until October 31. This will encompass the qualifying period for both the AKC National Championship (ANC) and Westminster.

Dogs that are owned or co-owned by the forenamed may compete in this competition but must be handled by a non-professional handler. *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.* Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistant to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (Meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month Beginner Puppy Competition. There will be a Best of 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy and a Best of Opposite Sex 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy chosen.

All dogs that are owner-handled and are not exhibited in the National Owner-Handled Series by professional handlers* meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward's book & the catalog. **Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers, household members and current assistants to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition during the entire show. A current assistant is defined by anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend, however current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.**

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are competing in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors at 7:30 am Friday, September 25, 2020. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best of Breed judging for Specialty 2. This is a self-cleaning site!

No private exercise pens allowed in building.

As a courtesy to fellow competitors, we ask that any bitches in season not be in The Paw until after Obedience and Rally are completed.

The welfare of exhibitors' children is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitors. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control & restraint over their children while on the show site.

A Judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp). Ramps can be used in an emergency situation to judge any breed. In an emergency situation an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.

By entering this show, all owners, handlers, breeders and kennels agree that all rights to televise, videotape, photograph, advertise, promote and publicize or otherwise exploit this show, or the per-sons or animals participating in it or the results of the competition before, during or after the event, shall belong solely to The American Kennel Club and their respective assigns, including the use of the names, like-nesses or biographical matter of all dogs, owners, handlers, breeders and kennels participating in the show and no such owner, handler, breeder or kennel shall allow any other party to make commercial use of any video-tape or photograph of any person or animal participating in this competition.

A Recording Fee of 50 cents for each dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each recordable single-entry class at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.50 1st Entry & \$3.00 additional entry of same dog will be required for each entry in Rally. (American Kennel Club Rally Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 3) These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. There is a \$2.00 event service fee for the 4-6 month beginner puppy competition.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.

Dogs allowed in rings during judging only.

Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendents will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. **Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.**

The Twin Cities Vizsla Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show, none will be mailed.

All checks issued as prizes are the sole responsibility of the recipient. Lost, stolen and/or misplaced checks will not be replaced. Checks are valid for 90 days. The Secretary is not able to cash checks.

RETURNED CHECKS/DECLINED CREDIT/DEBIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry fee. Fees must be paid in guaranteed funds. Checks will not be accepted. The Superintendent will add a fee for completing the transaction and/or reprocessing the entries. Repeated occurrences from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Superintendent.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the show committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due

to being entered incorrectly. There is no entry fee refund for duplicate entry or for bitches in season (except for those entered in Obedience and Rally). Any exhibitor with a bitch that was entered in Obedience or Rally and is in season on the trial date will be refunded one-half of the Obedience or Rally entry fee paid. Written notification must be in the hands of the Show Secretary no later than one-half hour before the start of the trial. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. The returned items must be made good by cash or money order before the dog will be allowed in the ring. Anyone who submits any payment to the TCVC, whether credit card or check, that is later returned for any reason by the bank or charged back will be assessed a \$30.00 returned-item fee by the TCVC.

The Twin Cities Vizsla Club, the Show Superintendent, their agents, employees, etc, assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

No entry shall be made, and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures or the "Agreement" on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form.

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

The Twin Cities Vizsla Club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes; and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the club or any official thereof.

Refunds of \$3.00 & less will not be issued due to the costs of processing. An administrative fee of \$2.00 will be charged for all cancellations or changes made prior to closing of entries.

Faxed Entries are not accepted.

Online entries can be made at www.tcvc.org and are available to cardholders of Visa and MasterCard. A \$3.00 fee will be added to each transaction for the use of this service.

Telephone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC entry forms are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

FAX/EMAIL ENTRIES AND PAPER ENTRIES WITH CREDIT CARD ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE METHODS FOR ENTRIES AND WILL NOT BE PROCESSED. Online Entries and Checks by Mail are not affected by this change. If mailing be sure to have the entry with check enclosed arrive prior to the closing date of the show. Please note all entries received via fax or email and/or paper entries with credit card information will be shredded/deleted immediately upon delivery without processing. We are happy to accept entries with payment by check at the delivery address.

Exhibitors are governed by all rules or regulations of the American Kennel Club, civil authorities and/or building or location restrictions.

Owners must familiarize themselves with the agreement of the American Kennel Club referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this premium list. Rule books are available at the show, or individual copies may be obtained free from the AKC, 8051 Arco Corporate Drive, Suite 100, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390.

Identification tickets and judging programs will be emailed to the address given on the entry blank. If not received within the specified time limit prior to the show, notify Twin Cities Vizsla Club

Dogs that have, according to their owners' records, completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show, but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the Regular classes to the Best of Breed competition, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary one-half hour prior to the start of Regular conformation judging.

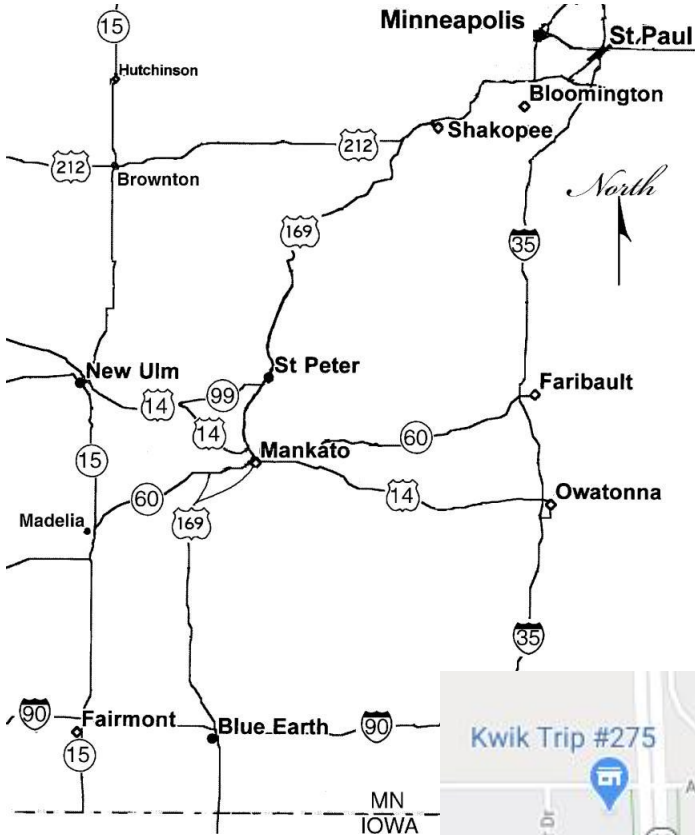

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.

- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name.
